- Newton Road through to Hawkins Drive
 - Conversations on-going with CDD

Other updates

- Hawkeye Ramp aesthetic issues with concrete
 - Structure and concrete are in great shape
 - Parking levels have some rough areas
 - Contractor will do some work on the surfaces
 - Need to improve the look and feel
 - Need to remove trip hazards and slipping potential in winter months
 - Work will add 4-7 weeks to schedule
 - Looking at a go-live closer to March 1
- Opening of Hawkeye Ramp questions
 - Lot 90 placement will be based on seniority
 - Emails have been sent out directly to qualified employees
